

**NIXA FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT
RESOLUTION # 001-2001
ORDINANCE # 2001-001**

WHEREAS, for the purpose of protection of the members of the District with safe regards to the use of fireworks for celebration of Independence Day.

WHEREAS, Section 321.220(12), for the purpose of providing fire protection to the property in the District, the district and, on its behalf, the board shall have the following powers, authority and privilege:

(12) To adopt and amend bylaws, fire protection and fire prevention ordinances, and any other rules and regulations not in conflict with the constitution and laws of this state, necessary for the carrying on of the business, objects and affairs of the board and of the district, and refer to the proper authorities for prosecution any infraction thereof detrimental to the district. Any person violating any such ordinance is hereby declared to be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, shall be punished as is provided by law therefor. The enactments of the fire district in delegating administrative authority to officials of the district may provide standards of action for the administrative officials, which standards are declared as industrial codes adopted by nationally organized and recognized trade bodies.

WHEREAS, Section 321.220(12), the Fire District will do a fireworks safety inspection as described in accordance with 320.106 to 320.161 RSMO before operation of the site is opened and commenced. Any other inspections can be conducted for ordinance compliance after the operation of the site has commenced.

WHEREAS, Section 321.220(12), the amount of fee to permit the operation of fireworks distribution will be \$250.00 per site within the corporate limits of the Fire Protection District. The money collected will be earmarked in a general fund for the district wide fireworks display.
